For Both Locations

Date: Tuesday, April 18, 2023

Address: 3551 N State Rd 7, Hollywood, FL 33021

Location: Seminole Okalee Indian Village and Museum, (across the street from Seminole Classic Casino Hollywood) Vendors will be allowed to set up between NOON and 6:00 PM on Monday, April 17th or beginning at 8:00 AM on Tuesday, April 18th. They must be fully set-up and ready for business by 8:45 AM on Tuesday, April 18th. All vendor vehicles must be moved to the designated parking area following set-up. Tear down can take place at 6:30 PM on Tuesday, April 18th, and must be completed by 7:30 PM.

Date: Thursday, April 20, 2023

Address: 34725 W. Boundary Road, Clewiston FL 33440

Location: Big Cypress Reservation, Ah-Tah-Thi-Ki Museum Park (across the street from the Museum) Vendors will be allowed to set up beginning at 8:00 AM on Thursday, April 20th and must be fully set-up and ready for business by 9:30 AM. All vendor vehicles must be moved to the designated parking area following set-up. Tear down can take place at 4:00 PM on Thursday, April 20th, and must be completed by 5:00 PM.

The Museum, and Okalee Village reserves the right to reject an application based on content or capacity and to assign booth location. Vendors are responsible for their own set up, tear down, sales, and manning of booths.

There will be no early tear down.
