

## Policies and Tips for Visiting the Museum

We hope that all visitors to the Ah-Tah-Thi-Ki Museum have a safe and pleasurable experience while here. Below you will find our general rules of decorum. These rules are put into place to help us protect our collections and facilities. Most importantly, remember that you are on sovereign land belonging to the Seminole Tribe of Florida. Please conduct yourself respectfully while on the reservation.

- 1. Food and drink (except water) are not allowed inside the Museum.
- 2. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times throughout the campus.
- 3. Smoking is not permitted in the Museum or on the Boardwalk. The entire facility is smoke free.
- 4. Please be mindful of fellow Museum visitors and staff. Courtesy to others should be exercised when talking on cell phones in gallery spaces and the theater. In addition, personal audio players are not permitted without headphones.
- 5. Disorderly, disruptive, abusive, or offensive language or actions are prohibited.
- 6. Large backpacks and bags may be subject to search at any time.
- 7. Flash photography is not permitted within the Museum galleries. Photography must be for noncommercial purposes only.
- 8. Appropriate attire is required, including shoes and shirts.
- 9. For your safety, and the safety of our artifacts, please do not touch the exhibits unless there is a sign indicating it may be touched.
- 10. Please do not feed, taunt, or touch any wildlife you may encounter on the grounds.
- 11. Please follow all posted signs and instructions.
- 12. The boardwalk entrance closes one hour prior to museum closing. Please return to the Museum promptly before our 5pm closing time.
- 13. Pets are not permitted on the Museum campus. Service animals are always welcome.
